About Tomsk

Tomsk is situated on the east bank of the river Tom, 60 km from its fall into the river Ob. From the earliest times, Tomsk was located on the Great Siberian Way, which connected eastern and western parts of Russia. Tomsk has a rich history and recently celebrated its 400th anniversary. Siberian taiga was always full of fur-bearing animals and rich in minerals.





For many years now, Tomsk became a hub of activity and attracted enterprising persons to the region. As time goes by, educational, industrial, and cultural complex were formed on this unique basis. At present, more than 500,000 people live in Tomsk and a quarter of population are young people.

Tomsk is also famous for its beautiful old-fashioned wooden buildings, which have withstood the test of time. In many ways, the historical districts of Tomsk look like an open-air museum of Russian architecture.

Tomsk is the oldest research and educational centre in Asian Russia. The largest universities of Tomsk have over a century-long history: in 1888 the first university was opened beyond the Urals—the Tomsk Emperor University (at present Tomsk State University); in 1900—the first technical institute—Technological Institute of the Emperor Nicholas II (at present Tomsk Polytechnic University), in 1902—the first teachers training institute—Tomsk Teachers Institute (at present Tomsk State Teachers Training University).
