The 1st International Research and Science Conference “Migalkin Readings” will be held to celebrate the 30th anniversary of the state authority establishment in the field of coordination foreign relations of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia) and the 10th anniversary of the founding of the Department of International Studies of the Institute of Modern Languages and International Studies of M.K. PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. The volume of the publication should not exceed 10 A4 typewritten pages.
2. Margins: top - 2 cm, bottom - 3.5 cm, right - 2.5 cm, left - 2.5 cm
3. Style of the main text: set font - Times New Roman, font size - 14, normal font, line spacing - single.
4. Abstract is given in Russian/English. The recommended average length of abstracts is up to 200 characters.
5. The recommended number of keywords is 5-8.
6. Full justification alignment.
7. Word wrap is automatic.
8. Initials and surname of the author - in bold italics on the right
9. The name of the place of work/study (common abbreviation is acceptable) in italics on the right.
10. The title of the report is given in capital letters in bold type in the center.
11. Footnotes do not apply.
12. Literature references. The list of references is formed in the order of citation. Font size - 12.
