Dear students, undergraduates and school students!

On **March 16, 2023**, the Institute of Modern Languages and International Studies of the M.K. Ammosov North-Eastern Federal University is holding its annual all-Russian scientific and practical conference with international participation *the 18th Semenov Readings*. The conference will be held in a mixed format: **live and online**.

The Semenov Readings are held for the 18th time as a tribute to the founder of the Faculty of Foreign Languages of the Yakut State University, now Institute of Modern Languages and International Studies, NEFU, **Apolloniy Semenov** (28.12.1903 - 23.10.1977), Candidate of Philology, associate professor.

Apolloniy Semenov made a great contribution to the development of linguistic education in the Sakha Republic (Yakutia). He was awarded the title of the "Honored School Teacher of the YASSR". He was also awarded medals "For Labor Valor in the Great Patriotic War of 1941-45", "For Valiant Labor in Commemoration of the 100th Vladimir Lenin Anniversary". Graduate students are also invited to participate in the conference out of the general competition for the best reports. The selected articles will be included in the conference proceedings.

To participate in the conference:

By March 10, 2023, fill in the application form and attach your article on the web page of the conference <https://www.s-vfu.ru/semenov>. The name of the file with the article must include the Last name and First name of the first author. For example: Ivanov Ivan.doc .

After March 10, 2023, the electronic registration system will be closed, the application process will be stopped.

From March 11 to March 15, 2023, the selection of the received articles for inclusion into the Conference Program will be carried out. The participants will receive a notification of the selection results to the email address specified during registration.

The conference proceedings will be published in the collection of proceedings of the All-Russian Scientific and Practical Conference with international participation *the 18th Semenov Readings*. The proceedings will be published on the website of the scientific electronic library elibrary.ru with indexation in the scientometric database of the **RSCI**. Publication of the article and electronic versions of the collection mail-out are free of charge.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject and not publish articles which:

- 1) are submitted out of the main topics of the conference sections;
- 2) do not contain scientific information;
- 3) do not meet the Publishing Standards of the Articles (see Appendix 1);
- 4) are of an abstract nature;
- 5) were received after March 10, 2023.

Key dates of the conference

December 15, 2022 – beginning of the registration and application process;

March 10, 2023 – completion of registration and application process;

March 16, 2023 – the Plenary Session and the work of the Sections of the Conference.

Publishing Standards of the Articles

All articles must meet the following standards:

1) The document must be submitted in the format of a text editor in doc, docx. The name of the file with the article must include the Last name and First name of the first author. For example: Ivanov Ivan.doc/docx.

2) Font: **Times New Roman, size 14**, line spacing - 1. **Margins:** top and bottom – 20 mm, left and right – 20 mm, paragraph indentation of 10 mm (without using space or tab), portrait orientation, automatic transfer, reference number and pages in square brackets: [1, 15].

3) **Pictures** and **Figures** should have a clear image and be kept in black and white.

4) The article should contain the following **general information:**

- title of the article (first line, center alignment);
- the next line with center alignment must include the author's last name, first name and patronymic (or middle name);
- the next line with center alignment must include the full name of the university /institute, college, faculty, group;
- the text of the article (justified, evenly distributed between the margins);
- list of references in alphabetical order (see Appendix 2)
- Full name and position of the supervisor (bottom right).

5) The **total volume** of the article should not be more than 5.0 typewritten pages (A4 sheet), **including** general information and a list of references.

6) Articles should be carefully edited taking into account the rules of the English language.

List of references

The sources used are listed at the end of the text under the heading List of references. Refer only to the works directly cited in the articles. It is not necessary to list all the important scientific articles and books read on the topic.

According to the **State Standard 7.1-2003 Bibliographic Record. Bibliographic Description of the Document. General Requirements and Rules of Compilation** the following elements of the bibliographic description are provided: author's last name, initials; title; information related to the title (information clarifying the main title of the book); information about responsibility (authors, editors, compilers); –information about the edition of the publication; general information (place of publication, publisher's name, year of publication); quantitative characteristics (how many pages are in the book).

Examples of bibliographic description

a) Description of a book by one author

Biryukov P.N. International Law: Student Book / P.N. Biryukov. - M.: Jurist, 2000. - 416 p.

With a parallel title (in Russian and a foreign language), they are separated from each other by a sign =

Sheveleva S.A. English on Economics = Английский для экономистов: Student Book for Universities with Economics major / S.A. Sheveleva. - 2nd ed., supplemented and revised - M.: UNITY-DANA, 2005. - 415 p.

If the book is translated from a foreign language, then this is indicated in the continuation of the title and separated by a colon. If there is a surname of the translator, it should be indicated in the information about responsibility.

Vance D. Blue World: translated from English / D. Vance. - M.: VLADOS, 2004. - 698 p.

Asherwood B. The ABC of Communication / B. Asherwood; translated from English. I. Y. Bagrovoy, R.Z. Panova; scientific ed. L. M. Inkova. - M.: Liberia, 1995. - 173 p.

b) A description of a book by two or three authors

First, the surname of the first author is indicated, and after the slash, both are listed with initials before the surname.

Stepin V. S. Philosophy of Science and Technology: Study Guide for universities / V. S. Stepin, V. G. Gorokhov, I. A. Rozov. - M.: Gardarika, 1996. - 400 p.

c) Description of the book under the title

If a book is written by four or more authors, then after the title, the first author is indicated behind a slash in the area of responsibility and [et al.] is added.

Property Tax: Comments and Explanations / V.R. Bernik [et al.]. - M.; Yekaterinburg: Analitika-press: Finance, 1997. - 80 p.

The title describes collective textbooks, monographs, collections of articles, etc.

Practical English Course: 2nd year: Student Book for universities / edited by V.D. Arakin. - M.: VLADOS, 2003. - 520 p.

Essays of Public Pedagogy / under the general ed. B. V. Kupriyanov; Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation, Kostroma St. Uni. - Kostroma: Publishing House of KSU, 2004. - 104 p.

d) A separate volume of a multi-volume edition

Fasmer M. Etymological Dictionary of the Russian Language: in 4 vols. Vol.1 / M. Fasmer. - M.: Enlightenment, 1986. - 831 p.

Bram A.E. Animal Life: in 3 vols. Vol. 2. Birds / A.E. Bram; revised for youth according to the latest German edition. Edited by A. M. Nikolsky - M.: Terra, 1993. - 324 p.

e) Articles from collections, magazines and newspapers

Article from a collection of articles:

Alexandrova T.N. Nomination Fundamentals of Modernity Historicisms / T.N. Alexandrova // Philological Readings of the Faculty of Foreign Languages. - Vologda, 2001. - Issue 3. - p. 3-4.

Article from a magazine:

Korovyakovsky, D.G. Legal and Economic Aspects of Attracting Foreign Investments into the Russian economy / D.G. Korovyakovsky // Finance and Credit. - 2007. - No. 10. - pp.70-80.

If the article has two or three authors, they are all listed behind a slash with initials before the surname. If there are more than three authors, the first author is indicated behind the slash and [et al.] is added.

g) Description of a review
