

Regulations for the All-Russian Student Olympiad (VCO) in Mathematics

1. The regulations for the All-Russian Student Olympiad (VCO) in mathematics determine the rules for holding the Olympiad caused by measures aimed at preventing the spread of coronavirus infection (COVID-19) in the Russian Federation.
2. The Olympiad is held on the subject "Mathematics".
3. The format of the Olympiad is correspondence - for all participants of the Russian Federation and foreign countries on the condition of using remote control.
4. The Olympiad is held for five astronomical hours, to solve 7 tasks from the course of higher mathematics, the complete of each is estimated at 7 points.
5. The Jury ensures that the questions of the participants will be answered within one hour after the Olympiad starts. The questions and answers will be held through a chat window (to the right of the video window) in the proctoring system. The Jury will not answer the questions received after that time.
6. The participant of the Olympiad should:
 - connect to the proctoring system on April 26, 2021 at 09:20 Moscow time by following the instructions of the system;
 - have their own stationery (at least 2 pens with blue or black ink, a ruler and other items not prohibited by these rules). Pens with red or green ink are not allowed;
7. The participant may have nearby drinks in transparent package, chocolates and cookies in non-rusty package.
8. Participants of the Olympiad are not allowed during the performance of tasks:
 - use means of communication, photo, audio and video equipment not related to the proctoring system;
 - go out of the visibility of the system cameras;
 - interact, exchange any materials or give them to other people.
9. In case of violations of the rules of the Olympiad and the instructions of the proctoring system the organizer of the Olympiad has the right to interrupt the session, stop the Olympiad, cancel the results (including the results of the analysis of the post-Olympiad video recordings).

10. Use of reference books, Internet sources and other information materials during the Olympiad is strictly forbidden!
11. To control the Olympiad a proctor (observer) is present in the system. Also, if possible, each team will be assigned a proxy from the participating universities. The proxy will supervise the Olympiad, including the sending of answers by the participant.
12. During the Olympiad participants may go to the lavatory, informing the proctor in advance through the chat in the proctoring system.
13. Participants can finish the Olympiad ahead of time. After the Olympiad ends within 30 minutes the participant should send a high-resolution scanned work in PDF format in one file through the MOODLE system. In those cases, when there is no possibility to scan the work it is allowed to send good quality pictures taken via smartphone. Poor image quality can have a negative impact on the result.
14. Works sent after the specified time are not allowed to be checked.
15. During the check the jury may ask participants of the Olympiad via e-mail or cell phone, specified in the registration form, to explain the entries.
16. The preliminary results will be sent to the participants' e-mail addresses approximately by 12 o'clock Moscow time on April 29.
17. Participants may submit an appeal to the jury. Applications are accepted only via e-mail, from which participants will receive the mailing of materials and preliminary results.
18. The final results for all nominations will be announced at the closing ceremony. After the closing ceremony the results table will be placed at the official site of the Olympiad
